Addendum #3 is being issued to include the following edits and/or clarifications:

1. Does this project have a precast concrete building in the plans?

All the listed sites are County, State, and Federal-owned with towers, antenna mounting capabilities, equipment shelters, and utility power. The intent of this RFP is to utilize the existing resources at each of the facilities. Metro doesn't believe any additional structures (specifically additional equipment shelters/generator shelters, etc.) will be needed or required.

2. Related to your Q & A on Addendum #3:

"Would Metro consider less than five Hops?"

Submit with at least three Hops, and Metro will consider based on other relevant factors."

I only saw 3 sites and 2 hops in the diagram and list of sites. Please clarify.

This RFP is for 2 hops (Metro to NWS/NWS to Garfield).

A question from a Potential Bidder was referring to #6 on the Original RFP dated 7/28/17 -- *PROPOSER MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS (page 7 of 34)* Question # 1 "Has your company successfully completed any digital microwave communication system construction projects with a minimum of five (5) hops?"

That Potential Bidder requested a reduction to 3 hops.

3. Should Potential Bidder quote a hot-standby protected system?

Please quote a hot-standby protection system as an option. This is where Metro saw the need for Item #20 in the RFP (page 27 of 34); without hot-standby, it would be of greater importance for spare RFU's DAK's, etc. cards.

The specifications of the original Request for Quotations dated 7/28/17 as well as previous addendums are to be included as a part of this Addendum #4. Once quotations are unsealed, all documents become public record. Metro Emergency Operations Center reserves the right to reject any and/or all proposals and to waive any informality in bidding.
